# WHAT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP?

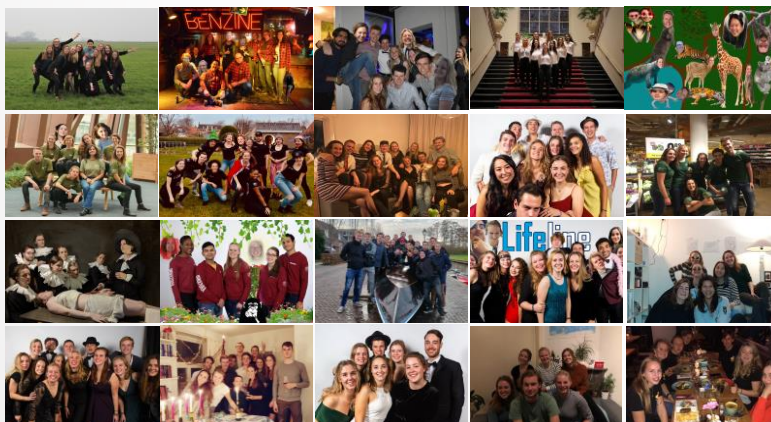

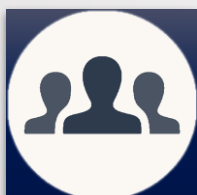

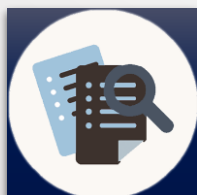
