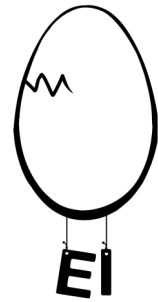
Dear reader,

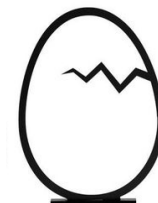
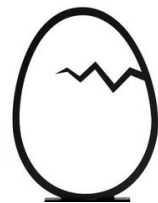
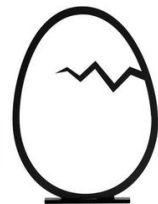
the activities

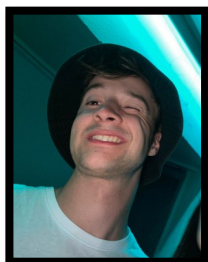
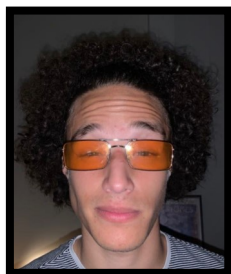

Time for the main man himself, our lighthouse JoJo. Mind you, he does not have red hair.

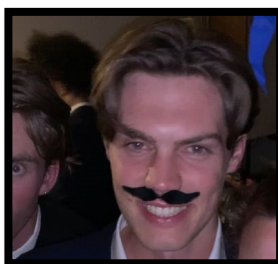
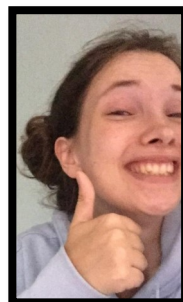
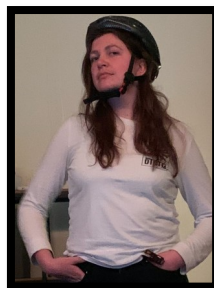

What is the most memorable party you have ever created?

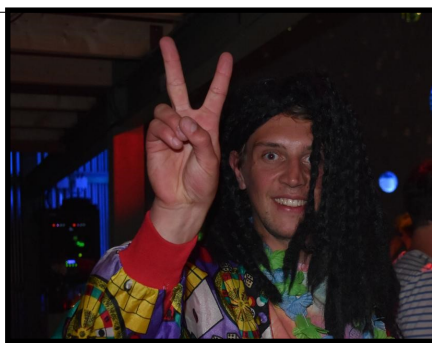
In Idun, the end of the year party of 2019.

IDUN TALK: USEFUL ABBREVIATIONS

Like any group of people that see each other as much as we do, members of Idun have created their own language. Some of the words used by us will sound strange to you, so here is a little list to help you understand:

ADL: abbreviation for Antonius Deusinglaan. Most of the times this refers to building ADL2, the educational building for Life Science & Technology at the UMCG. Location for some lectures and "het Huisje".

UMCG: Abbreviation for Universitair Medisch Centrum Groningen (a.k.a. ADL1). Faculty-building for Medicine and Dentistry. Location for some lectures and practicals.

Zernike: The Zernike-complex in the north of Groningen. Location of Faculty of Science and Engineering and the examination building.

Bernoulliborg: One of the new buildings on Zernike, blue building with the large lecture-

room.

CvL: Abbreviation for Centrum voor Levenswetenschappen, however nowadays it is known as Linnaeusborg.

Suite: Two rooms on the first floor of the CvL. The Wabbersuite is a chill spot for members of Idun, where you can enjoy coffee, tea, beer or soft drinks. Every Thursdayafternoon there is a Borrel. The other room is the boardroom (**het Hok**). The board is at this location on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

IduNacht: Monthly party in the Pakhuis, organized by the FC Partysquad. Free entry for members and cheap beer! Don't miss out on these great parties!

Suiteborrel: Borrel in the Suite. Every Thursday afternoon organized by the Wabber.

Lifeline: The Idun magazine. 5 issues are made every year.

Foreign committee

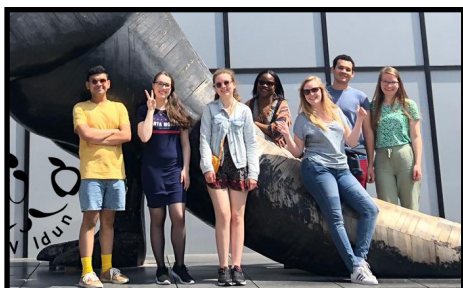

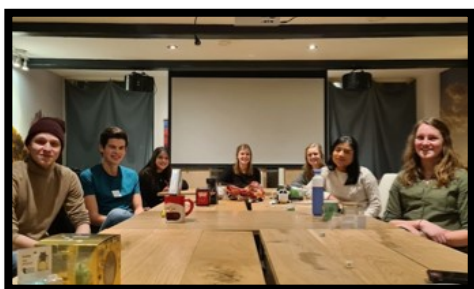


Editorial committee

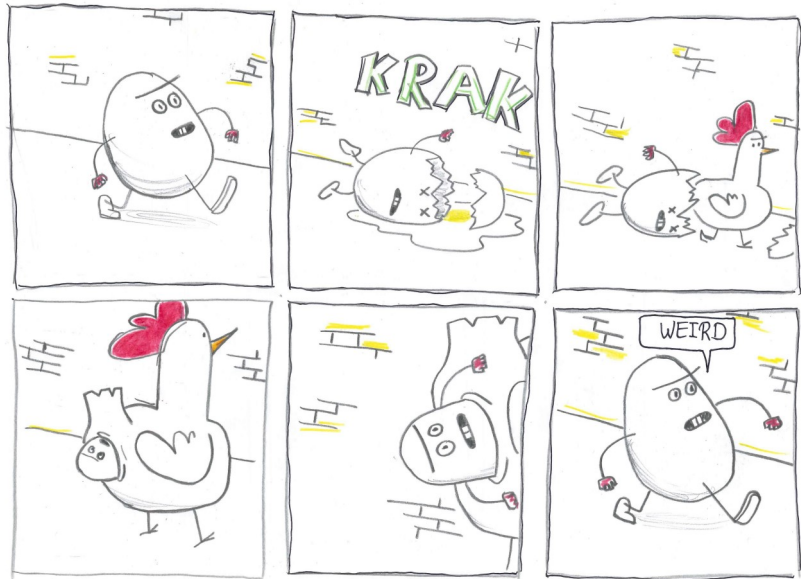
